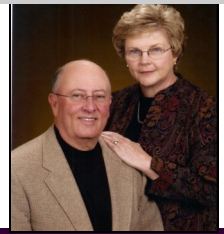

Dear GHI Friends:

Greetings in the Name of the Lord! I am sitting at my desktop and thinking about how the “much more” of Romans 5 transitions into the day to day life of GHI. As Paul deals with the overflow of being justified by faith, GHI also stands in the eternal fact that what God initiates, He sustains, which in itself is a “much more” life. He is the One who is forever giving much more than we can ever ask or think. He always does exceedingly abundantly above all we could ever ask or anticipate. What a Provider we have; but built in to all the promises of God and what He is initiating in our lives, is the idea that none of what God desires to do for us will happen apart from it being accompanied by a living faith to believe and expect it to be on the way. In Hebrews 11 alone, all 21 of our Old Testaments friends were said to have been justified by faith. This means they listened to what God was saying and walked it out with Him. During the past month, we hosted for a few days our Directors from India and Ghana, James Sundar and Eugene and Emma Narh. They reminded us of the work in their respective parts of the vineyard and just as they were leaving the USA, Steve and Ros Griffiths, friends of 22 years, came to us for a 9 day stay as they were on their way home to Adelaide, Australia. Steve teaches in our college in India on an ad hoc basis during the year.

GHANA ACTIVITY

Evangelist Godfried Tei reported that their work in the Ashanti Region in August was very fruitful. They hosted 10 Film Crusades, preaching to 10,800 people with 5,500 coming from the crowd repenting of their sins and declaring their faith in the finished work of

My lower back issues and pain has reached the point where I got another MRI last week and am now awaiting a neurosurgeon's opinion on September 28. My last MRI was 3 years ago and there has been further deterioration since that one. Surgery?? We don't know yet but it wouldn't surprise me. I would really value your prayers concerning all of this. Ten years ago, a former surgeon told me that if I wanted any quality of life when I reached my 'golden years' to stop doing long haul, overseas travel and the kind of work I was doing once I arrived. I proceeded to do another 50 projects and now I am facing life at 67 depending on His grace and care to cover my disobedience.

Finally, celebrate with me the 17 world-wide projects that have been completed this year. Collectively, our 45 missionaries and some USA/UK teams have planted 4 new churches, presented the Gospel in 465 different settings to 199,503 people with 91,970 coming out of the crowds to declare Jesus as their personal Savior and Lord. If we will go, He will go before us and prepare the fields for the harvest.
