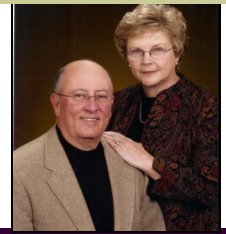

From Mack and Dottie

Dear Friends,

The Bible says, “God is a sun and a shield, He gives grace and glory and no good thing will He withhold from them that walk uprightly”, Psalm 84.11. What a promise of blessing and favor we live under as we pursue righteousness.

It has been our pleasure this year especially to experience His sun! In our immediate area we have had 50+ days of 100 degrees or more and our earth is parched. We are now rationing water. We meet every Monday night to seek God’s face for rain. There are many who would not associate the lack of rain with God at all but I seem to remember God withholding rain in Elijah’s day for 3 ½ years for far less than what we as a nation are guilty of. Personally, I think it is far more presumptive to think that what we are experiencing is any less than the judgment of God on our land with this and other flooding and earthquakes that are happening. I firmly believe God is saying, return to me, repent and I will become that sun and shield that I have always intended to be. You could possibly call me a bit of a religious fanatic, go ahead, but it is something to spiritually take on board.

We stand in a position of awe and wonder for the great friends and supporters that God has sent to insure the Gospel continues to go forward; students get trained for the ministry; orphans and abused women receive care; and churches get planted. We finally received Godfried Tei’s report for his July work in Ghana where he preached in 14 venues to 16,500 people with 7,420 naming Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior...what a blessing!

To date, we have planted 4 new churches in Ghana – Anyinam, Ahenebronoso, Dermaa and Sekyere East. Please remember to pray for these young churches as they go through the formation months ahead! We received our India Director, James Sundar to our home and church this past week for a time of reporting and vision casting. He blessed many of us with his testimonies and went back home encouraged to the max!

For God’s glory only – in 2011, I am happy to report that **we have now preached in 455 venues** in Ghana and India **to nearly 189,000** people and have witnessed first-hand and have begun the follow up work on **over 86,000 dear people who have come out of darkness into light**. That means for every time one of our 45 missionaries steps up to preach, they are preaching to an average of 425 and they see 190 of them come out of the crowd and pray to receive Jesus as Savior and Lord...so thanks for your prayers and gifts to GHI. You who are reading who pray and give are the grease that keeps the wheels moving and you share in these victories! We are reaching the unreached because of your favor to us!

Continue to pray for the ongoing needs of The Father’s Home; new sound equipment, generator and a vehicle for one of our teams in Ghana. Pray for the slowing down of the rains in Ghana so we can complete a well in a needy village. Dottie joins me in sending our love!
